**AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR TO MODIFY THE NAME OF NORTH BASIN
TO SMUGGLERS COVE**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Stone Harbor in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey maintains within its borders a bay area know on the official tax map of the Borough as "North Basin"; and

WHEREAS, for many years both locals and visitors have referred to "North Basin" as "Smuggler's Cove"; and

WHEREAS, the commonly used name "Smuggler's Cove" is more familiar to many people and is a much more colorful name for a popular recreational area that includes the public marina, fishing area and boat launch.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Stone Harbor, in the County of Cape May and the State of New Jersey, duly assembled in public session this 16th day of January, 2007, that the preamble of this Resolution is hereby incorporated by reference;

BE *IT* FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized and directed to modify the name of the current "North Basin" to "Smuggler's Cove" on the official tax map of the Borough of Stone Harbor. The change shall include the parenthetical information (Formerly known as "North Basin") immediately below the words "Smuggler's Cove" on the official tax map of the Borough of Stone Harbor.


